THE ARMY HAVE WITHDRAWN FROM THE KOSANGAS PLA NT WHICH THEY TOOK OVER AT 5AM TODAY BUT WERE UNABLE TO OPERATE THE PLANT AND RETIRED .

THE ULSTER WORKERS 'COUNCIL ARE CONCERNED AT THE NUMBER OF CASES INVOLVING THE ARMY'S FAILURE TO OPERATE THE ESSENTIAL SERVICES.
