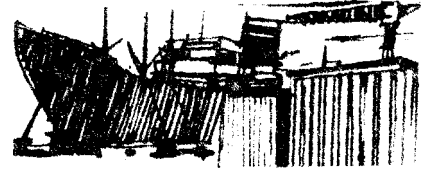

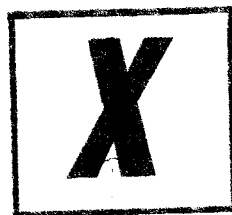
## The Formation of the ULSTER WORKERS COUNCIL

In the interests of the majority of workers, an organisation has emerged to rally the flagging moral of the Ulster people. The formation of a Six County Workers' Council was inevitable and convened under heavy pressure from grassroot Ulstermen. With honesty and straight talking all of the separate workers organisations have come together in response to the over-riding necessity to unite and save Ulster. In the months to come every worker will be given an opportunity to play his or her part by supporting the Ulster Workers' Council and to express their feeling about the present Stormont Executive. No doubt there are workers who do not care much for politics but even these people will sooner or later realise that the phoney executive and Sunningdale are the seeds from which a United Ireland will grow.

### WHY THE ULSTER WORKERS COUNCIL

This New Council **will** be the controlling **body** and the organising body for the various workers organisations throughout the six counties. The council will play an

important role in representing the legitimate interests of the Ulster **workers**. Only the combined voice of the workers across the entire province can save our heritage and keep us free from the disaster of a United **Ireland**.

## IS THE UWC . A POLITICAL BODY?

This **is** a complex question which begs for a straight yes/no answer, but such **an answer** would not justify the **nature** of the organisation. The UWC is **not** affiliated to any one political party and owes **allegiance** to **none**. The UWC will accept members **from** all political parties provided **they** accept the **constitution** and rules of the organisation. **The UWC in reflecting the views of the workers** will seek to exercise a positive **influence** on the **Secretary of State** in order to **satisfy the aspirations of the Ulster working class**. By retaining a separate political **identity** the UWC can emerge **as** the true voice of the Ulster worker **thereby** filling the **vacuum** which has existed throughout **the present crisis**.

## IS THE UWC A PARAMILITARY OR ORGANISATION?

**Definitely Not!** It is the **opinion of the organisers** that the aims and **aspirations** of the Ulster **Workers** are legitimate and **genuine** and should be pursued through **non-violent action** and protest. It **is the intention** of the UWC to **recruit all workers irrespective of trade, occupation or profession** and to **protect the interests** of all its members **in times of trouble**.

## WHO ORGANISES THE ULSTER WORKERS' COUNCIL

The council is **comprised** of representatives from each of the six counties **and** from Belfast, making a total of 7 groups. Each group is headed by a County Committee complete with Chairman, Secretary, **Treasurer**, Press Officer **etc.** **This** County Committee is elected from factory delegates **who** are themselves elected by their fellow workers at Branch **level**. At every stage the UWC will reflect the opinion of the workers and **seek** to uphold the **principles of democracy**.

## WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP?

If you have read the **news sheet** and can identify **with the basic reasoning** and the **outlines of policy**, then you can help by **discussing** the contents **with** your workmates and colleagues. **If you wish to form** a factory or office branch then **start** right away by **talking to all** those who are **interested**. It is better to involve yourself in **this** struggle than to stand aside and complain. For our **part**, we will guarantee that you will **be** proud to **be** a member of this new organisation.
