POLITICAL TALKS

To: Members of the Business Committee

1. As agreed at the meeting of the Business Committee on Wednesday 29 April, please find attached:

- (a) the draft minutes of that meeting;
- (b) a paper setting out the Government's view of the fundamental political realities which emerged from the previous talks; and
- (c) a paper on "Common Themes" incorporating the revisions suggested at the Business Committee meeting.
