Public protest over Enniskillen tribute removal

Protest in Fermanagh

There was a public protest in Enniskillen last night over the removal of a photographic tribute to the victims of the Enniskillen bomb from the local fire station.

It was removed following claims that it could be in breach of equality legislation.

This year marks the 20th anniversary of the Enniskillen bombing.

Chief Fire Officer for the District said: the Fire and Rescue Service fully recognises the significance of the Enniskillen bombing on the whole community, as well as fire crews who at the time worked tirelessly to assist victims of the bomb.

Protestors handed in a letter calling for the memorial to be restored and say they intend to meet the Equality Commission about the issue.
