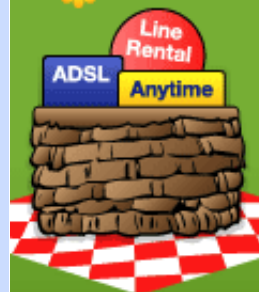

Brothers in court over feud murder

Two brothers have been charged with the murder of a UDA man during a loyalist feud.

They were also accused of membership of the UVF after Tommy English, 40, was gunned down in front of his wife at his home near Belfast in October 2000.

The accused are David Stewart, 38, from Ballyearl Crescent in Newtownabbey and Robert Stewart, 34, from Carntall Rise, in Newtownabbey.

Both men deny the charges.

It is the first case to be brought to court by the autonomous Historical Enquiries Team, set up to investigate unsolved murders.

HET Detective Inspector Mary Mooney told the court she could connect the accused with four counts each of murdering Mr English and membership of the UVF.


They were remanded in custody until September 4.
