Nuala O` Loan says HET and Police Ombudsman should work together

The former Police Ombudsman Nuala O` Loan has said there should be one unit dealing with historical inquiries and complaints to the Police Ombudsman`s Office.

She made the statement after the head of the Historical Enquiries Team, which is tasked with re-examining murders during the troubles, admitted they needed more time.

The team was set up three years ago and given six years to re-examine more than 3,200 deaths.

HET director Dave Cox said they had only got as far as 1974 and would need an extra three years.

The HET, which is based in Lisburn and employs 180 people, has used up half of the £34m budget allocated to it.
