### Seven held over double murder

Monday, November 12, 2007

Seven people have been arrested in connection with the murders of two men in Belfast last March.

Gardai arrested three men and a woman in Dundalk and Dublin on Sunday while the PSNI said three men are being questioned in Antrim about the killings.

Edward Burns (36) was shot in the head near the Falls Road, while Joseph Jones (38) was beaten to death in Ardoyne.

The pair were both killed during separate attacks on the same night amid tensions within dissident republicanism.

The Independent Monitoring Commission has claimed the Continuity IRA killed the men because they established a rival group.


