The organisers of this weekend's Bloody Sunday march have appealed to young people not to get involved in sectarian clashes in the area around the Fountain during Sunday's commemoration. The Bloody Sunday Trust has written to a number of local schools asking for their help in preventing sectarian clashes at the interface between Bishop Street and the Fountain. The move comes after a number of incidents in recent years when nationalist youths have clashed with young people from the Fountain after the commemoration march.

The letter asked for school principals to impress upon their pupils the need to respect the memory of those who were murdered on Bloody Sunday.

“In coming together at the anniversary we remember those murdered on Bloody Sunday and demonstrate our support for the continuing campaign for truth and justice. In particular we are calling on young people to stay away from the Fahan Street, Fountain and Bishop Street interface and to say no to sectarianism in every shape or form.

“Incidents of this nature only divert attention from the commemoration and show no respect for the victims of Bloody Sunday,” the letter stated.
