Commemorative Bloody Sunday marches could soon be a thing of the past depending on the results of the Saville Inquiry.

John Kelly, whose brother Michael was shot dead on Bloody Sunday, said that the march may continue every year if the results of the Inquiry are viewed as flawed by family members.

Mr. Kelly said: "Things are up for discussion. We certainly won't see the results of the Saville Inquiry this year. How we commemorate Bloody Sunday is up for debate when it becomes clear that the Saville Inquiry has found our relatives innocent."

Lord Saville is currently reviewing the evidence from the biggest legal tribunal in British history. By the end of April 2007 the cost of the Inquiry had exceeded Â£178million.
