Troubles group to report progress

The troubles legacy group co-chaired by Derry man Denis Bradley is to give a report on its progress tomorrow.

Mr. Bradley, of the Consultative Group on the Past, and co-chair Lord Robin Eames, will highlight the key issues they believe society will have to address in order to have a shared future that is not overshadowed by the past.

The group's final report is to be published later this year with a list of recommendations on how the North can deal with the legacy of the past.
