McShane Inquest hears of partner's shock

The partner of the 26 years old local man who died from multiple injuries after he was struck by an armoured personnel carrier during rioting in Derry twelve years ago has told the inquest into his death that she spoke to him in hospital shortly before he died.

Dermot McShane, from Hollymount Park in the Waterside, died on July 13, 1996, hours after he'd been struck by an eleven tonne Saxon carrier during rioting at Little James' Street.

His then partner, Geraldine Harkin, said she went to Altnagelvin Hospital after receiving word that Mr. McShane had been injured. She thought he'd been struck by a plastic bullet and when she arrived at the hospital she found Mr. McShane

"He said his leg was badly damaged. He said he was in pain. We just thought his leg was badly damaged. We just thought he was going to get his leg fixed and it was a terrible shock when he died ", she told the inquest.

Meanwhile, the inquest was also told that the driver of the Saxon vehicle that struck Mr. McShane , Private Daniel Moran, was the only soldier in the personnel vehicle. The Coroner, Brian Sherrard, said he'd sent a letter to the police in the jurisdiction in which Mr. Moran is currently living. The police, in turn, hand-delivered the letter to Mr. Moran but, so far, no reply has been received from him.

The inquest continues.
