



BRADLEY TO ATTEND DAIL DEBATE ON QUINN MURDER

SDLP Newry and Armagh MLA Dominic Bradley will accompany the Quinn family to attend a debate on the murder of Paul Quinn in Dáil Éireann on Thursday 7th February.

The debate has been arranged by Fine Gael leader Enda Kenny and it is expected that Justice Minister Brian Lenihan will speak.

The debate will run from 11:00 AM to around 12:30. The Quinn family, Enda Kenny and Dominic Bradley will be available to the media at around 12:45 PM at the Kildare Street gate to Leinster House.

The Assembly Business Committee has allotted time at 2:00 PM on Tuesday 19th February to debate Dominic's motion on the murder. The motion reads:

"That this Assembly condemns the brutal murder of Paul Quinn; notes the clarification by the two governments that they do not hold the view that the victim was involved in criminality of any kind; further notes the assessments of Sir Hugh Orde and the International Monitoring Commission that current and former members of the Provisional IRA were involved in this crime; and calls upon everyone to encourage people to come forward and assist the police investigations north and south."

The next public meeting in the Quinn campaign will be held in Newry Town Hall at 8:00 PM on 20th February
