SDLP Newry Armagh MLA Dominic Bradley said the young men of Cullyhanna must all heed the words of Briege Quinn, who called for no retaliation of any kind for the murder of her son Paul.

He said: "There are reports in the media and elsewhere of altercations between some young men in the area. If the reports are true, I would call on them to stop right now.

"The Quinn Support Group made clear from the very beginning that there should be no finger-pointing of any kind in relation to the murder, and proposed covering up graffiti which had appeared. Briege Quinn was very explicit when she said retaliation of any kind, even at the level of window-breaking, hurt her and hurt her family and Paul's memory."

Cllr Geraldine Donnelly said: "Some people may feel that minor rows or daubing walls are small issues in the context of such a brutal murder, but that is not the point. Law-breaking of any kind, no matter how small, is playing straight into the hands of Paul's killers. It is also a serious distraction from the campaign. We must all stay focused on the murder which is at the core of this case and the need to get truth and justice for the Quinn family."
