LOCKWOOD COMMITTEE REPORT.

HIS WORSHIP THE MAYOR REFERRED TO ACTION PROPOSED TO BE TAKEN BY THE UNIVERSITY FOR DERRY COMMITTEE IN CONNECTION WITH A PUBLIC DEMONSTRATION TO BE MADE AT STORMONT ON THURSDAY, 18TH INSTANT. HIS WORSHIP THE MAYOR STATED THAT HE WAS SURE THAT THE COMMITTEE WOULD WISH TO SUPPORT THE ACTION COMMITTEE IN THIS MATTER AND HE, ACCORDINGLY, PROPOSED; ALDERMAN HEGARTY SECONDING :-

"THAT WE HEREBY AGREE TO GIVE FULL SUPPORT TO THE EFFORTS OF "UNIVERSITY FOR DERRY" COMMITTEE IN CONNECTION WITH THE PUBLIC DEMONSTRATION TO BE MADE AT STORMONT ON THURSDAY, 18TH INSTANT, AND TO GRANT TO THEM UP TO £100 TO BE EXPENDED AT THE DISCRETION OF OUR UNIVERSITY SUB-COMMITTEE.

FURTHER, WE ASK THAT THURSDAY, 18TH FEBRUARY, 1965 SHOULD BE REGARDED AS A LOCAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY EXCEPT FOR ESSENTIAL SERVICES, SO THAT THE GREATEST POSSIBLE NUMBERS MAY ATTEND AT STORMONT."

THE MOTION WAS ACCEPTED UNANIMOUSLY ON THE UNDERSTANDING THAT IT WOULD BE SUBMITTED TO A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL ON WEDNESDAY, 17TH FEBRUARY.
