## CATHOLIC:NON-CATHOLIC COMPARISONS

## INTRODUCTION

There has been increasing attention focused recently on Protestant/Catholic differentials in education arising out of a variety of Government initiatives in the area of equal opportunity, such as the Employment Equality Review, the SACHR Reports and Targeting Social Need. In view of the need for Divisions to be aware of the existence of such differentials and to ensure that monitoring systems are established or in place, it was considered helpful to pull together a compendium of the current information held by Statistics Branch in this area. This should prove useful to those charged with the monitoring of equal opportunity in the delivery of education services, and of interest to those with a less direct responsibility.

Throughout the Briefing, data is presented on a Catholic/Non-Catholic split as this is more accurate than a Catholic/Protestant division.
