Summary

A quiet day all round. Parades so far have passed off without incident and the funeral service of Richard, Mark and Jason Quinn took place in Ballymoney, with burial at Rasharkin.

Detail

There were no reports of any incidents at today's parades. Portadown District LOL NO 1 chose not to attend the annual event at Scarva and to stay at Drumcree instead. Drumcree was reported quiet throughout the day.

ATO was tasked to a suspect pipe-like object at Dunmurry; and a suspect jiffy bag in the post office at Cookstown addressed to "1 Garvaghy Road, Drumcree". At 1633 hours a suspect car was reported in Bangor town centre. There was a 20-minute warning. The area has been cleared; there are no further details at present.

Close Contact Talks

Efforts continue to reconvene Saturday's close contact talks between the GRRC and representatives of Portadown District LOL NO 1. Some hope remains that the talks will resume later this week.
