#### Key Statistics - 1st July to 30 September 2009

- > There were 10,265 persons stopped and searched under Section 44 of the Terrorism Act. This a marked increase from the 3,568 persons stopped and searched under this legislation last quarter (an increase of 188%), although this increase can be largely attributed to Operation Descent\*. Of the 10,265 stopped and searched this quarter, 39 persons were subsequently arrested.
- > There were 6,074 persons stopped and searched under PACE of whom 483 persons were subsequently arrested.
- > 1,697 persons were stopped and questioned under Section 21 of the Justice and Security Act and 166 persons were stopped and searched under JSA Section 24. Ten people were subsequently arrested (8 after JSA S21 and 2 after JSA S24).
- > Figures by gender and ethnicity are presented later in this report.

*Note: Quarterly figures may increase slightly in subsequent reports as outstanding stop/search forms are added after publication.  
Data Quality: These figures are derived from paper returns that are completed by police officers and collated by local Police Districts. Aggregate data are then forwarded to Central Statistics Unit on a quarterly basis who then perform a range of validation checks before publishing the data.*

\* Operation Descent ran from 18th September 2009 to 1st October 2009 and involved an increase in vehicle check points and high visibility patrols.

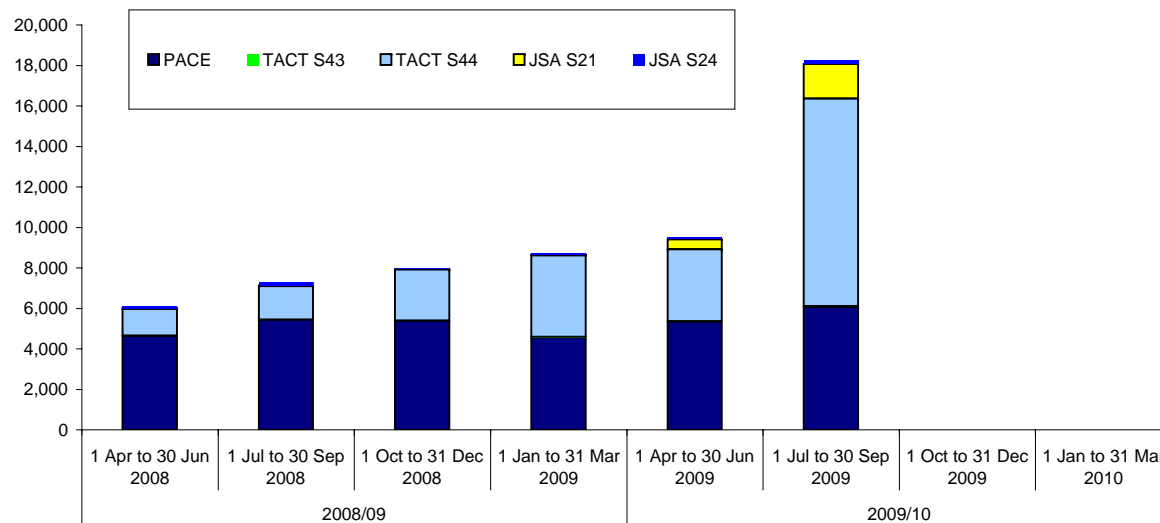

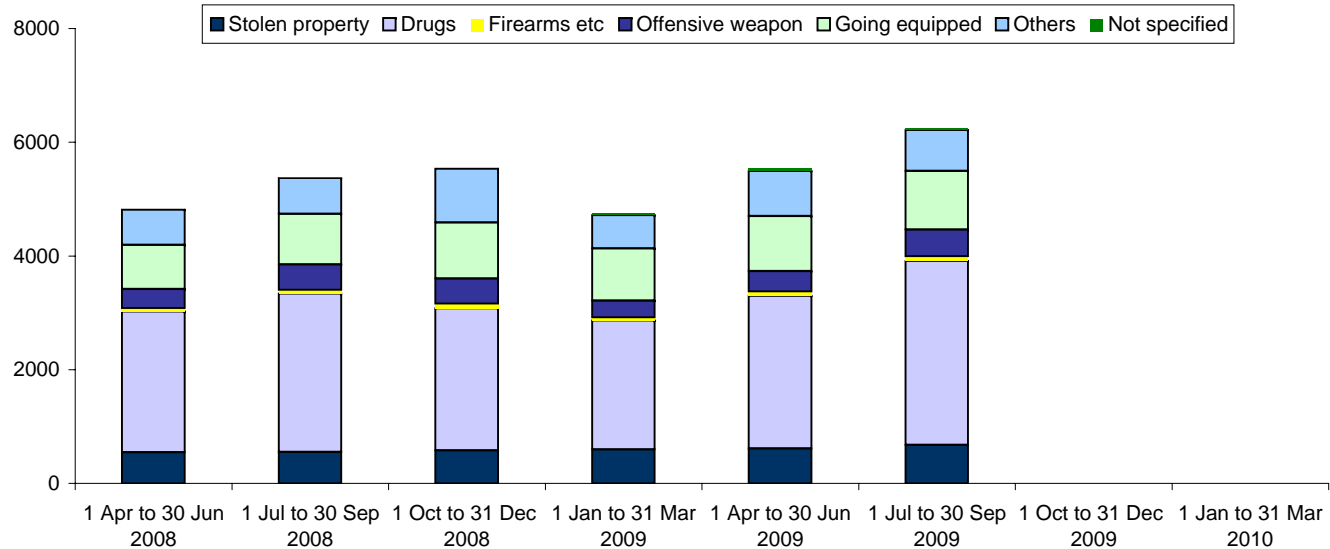
