The importance of this election should not be underestimated. It is an election to a body without power but which can be given power on certain conditions. The basic condition on which power can be restored to Stormont is if there is seventy per cent agreement among its members. What is not appreciated is that even if such agreement were reached every decision from then onwards would be by simple majority.
