STATEMENT OF PETER BERRY, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OF 6 ST. KEVIN'S PARK, DARTRY

On 17th April I received information from Mr. Michael Donnelly, a principal officer in the Department of Justice, as a result of which I spoke to my Minister and as a result I gave forthwith certain directions to Mr. Donnelly and to the Commissioner, Garda Siochána.

On Saturday, 18th April 1970, I received a telphone call at my home at 6.25 p.m. I recognised the voice of Mr. Haughey, Minister for \* Finance, with which I am familiar.

Without any preliminaries he asked me if I were aware of a certain cargo which was due to arrive at Dublin Airport on Sunday.

I replied:- "Yes, Minister".

Mr. Haughey then asked if the cargo could be let through if a guarantee were given that it would go direct to the North.

I replied :- "No".

He then said: "I think that is a bad decision".

I made no comment.

After a pause he asked: "Does the man from Mayo know about this?" I replied:- "Yes".

He then said :- "What will happen it when it arrives?"

I replied:- "it will be grabbed".

He then said :- "I had better have it called off".

Almost immediately after Mr. Haughey's conversation with me I received a telephone call from Chief-Superintendent Malone of Garda Meddeuarters givin, me certain information as a result of which I gave him information and directions.  $\int d d h$
